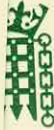

The villages of West Wiltshire which I visited last week are increasingly blighted by Mendip quarry lorries. Recently your council approved a set of applications in relation to the Torr works and Bartlett's and Coleman's quarries that will result in more heavy traffic. I learnt that this happened without consultation with my constituents in Wiltshire or their parish councils despite their clear interest.

I believe you may have failed in your duty to consult adequately, that your approvals are consequently questionable and that they do not contain the impact mitigation plan that might otherwise have been generated.

I would be grateful if you could say when you will be revoking the permissions you have given and restarting the consultation.
